# Blue Ridge Parkway

**For Your Information:** Land slides and other damage from Hurricanes in Sept have closed sections of the Blue Ridge Parkway. The two closures featured on this map are from Milepost 317-325 and from Milepost 344-355. The time line for repairs is not known. Be aware that traffic on the Parkway will increase during "leaf" season (October).

**Normal route:** Follow the Parkway.

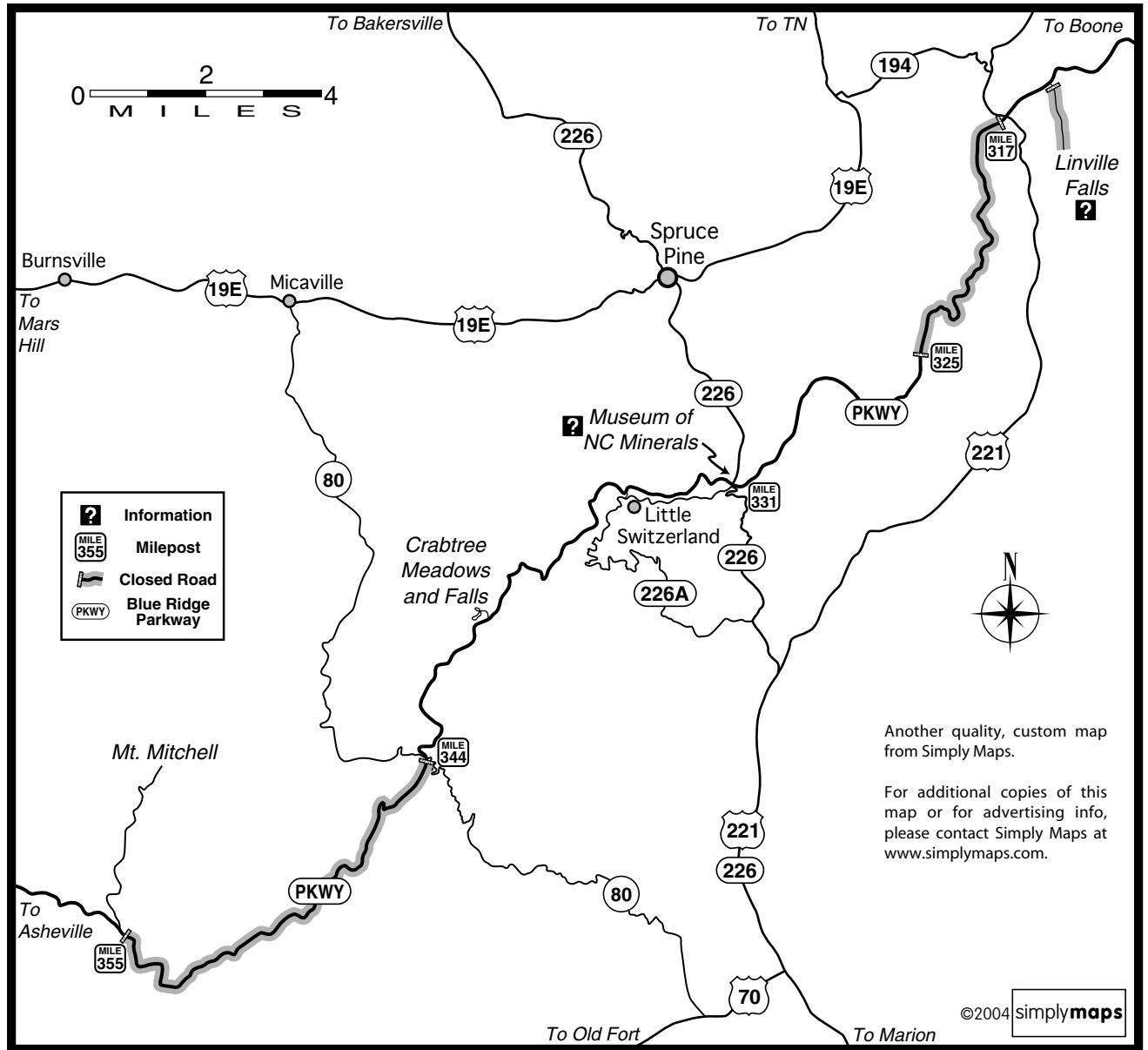
**Alternate routes:**

*Traveling South:* At Milepost 317, take 221 either north to 194 to 226 or south to 226. Rejoin the Parkway at Milepost 331. The Parkway is open to the north to Milepost 325. Continue south on the Parkway, being sure to enjoy the attractions that are cut off by the two closures. At Milepost 344, take 80 north to Micaville. Take 19E to I-26 east to Asheville. Take I-240 east to exit 7. Take 70 east for two miles to the Parkway entrance at Milepost 382.

*Traveling North:* The parkway is open to Milepost 355 at Mt. Mitchell. To continue north, it is easiest to return to Asheville, exit at Milepost 382, go two miles on 70 west. Take I-240 west to I-26 west to exit 9 and take 19E east to Micaville. Take 80 south to the Parkway at Milepost 344. Head north on the Parkway being sure to enjoy the attractions that are cut off by the two closures. The Parkway is open to Milepost 325. To continue north, exit the Parkway at Milepost 331, heading either north on 226 to 19E to 194 to 221 south or south on 226 to 221 north and rejoin the Parkway at Milepost 317.
